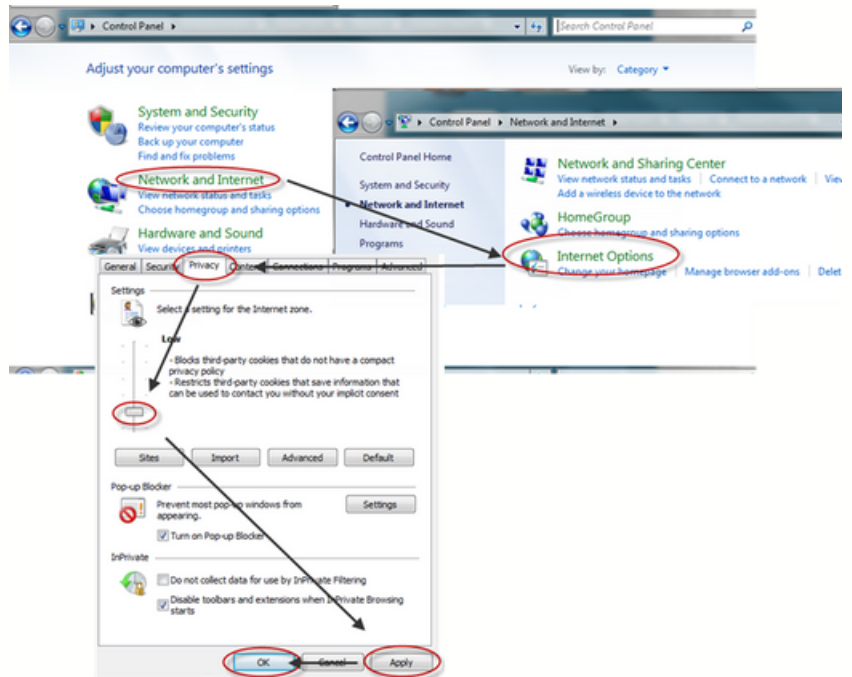
Section 1: Disabling Firewall/Anti-Virus Protection

- 1** Click on the Windows button: 
- 2** Click on "Control Panel" (you may have to select *Settings* then *Control Panel* depending on your menu setup)
- 3** Click on "System and Security"
- 4** Click on "Windows Firewall"
- 5** Click "Turn Windows Firewall on or off"
- 6** Turn all the Settings to "off"
- 7** Click on the "Ok" button
- 8** Click on the  in the upper right hand corner on the Security screen



**Keep in mind that sometimes your Anti-virus will block the installation of Vendor 360. It is best to temporarily disable your Anti-virus in addition to disabling your firewall. Once the application is installed both the Anti-virus and firewall(s) can be turned back on. If you do not know how to disable your Anti-virus program, please Google the instructions by searching "how to temporarily disable {insert Anti-virus program name}".*

Section 2: Changing Privacy Settings

- 1 While still in the control panel, click on "Network and Internet"
- 2 Click on Internet Options
- 3 Click on "Privacy" tab
- 4 Click and hold the slider, move it downward until it is set to Low
- 5 Click on the Apply button
- 6 Click on the OK button
- 7 Click on the red X in the upper right hand corner of the Control Panel



Section 3: Installing Application

- 1 Enter the following install link using a Google Chrome (🌐) browser:

- 2 Click the "Install" button:
